ProHousing Designation Application: The City of Hawthorne has prepared an application to the State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) to earn a ProHousing Designation.

The designation is awarded to cities and counties that are compliant with State Housing Element Law and have enacted policies and programs that support affordable and market-rate housing production and preservation. Earning the designation will enable the City to earn additional points on certain grant funding applications for competitive housing and infrastructure programs.
