SCOPE OF WORK

The work consists of Replacement of all taxiway edge lighting fixtures and associated cables and transformers, Replacement of the airfield lighting vault's Constant Current Regulators (CCRs), and Replacement of the airfield lighting control system's ACLS hardware and software. Replacement of runway edge and threshold/end light fixtures, and associated cable and transformers. Replacement of all existing airfield signage and associated transformers, and replacement of airfield guidance sign foundations and surface painted taxiway location markings as needed to rename all taxiways to conform to the naming convention proposed in the current ALP. Replacement the rotating beacon, including a new mounting pole and foundation and any necessary conduit per Plans and Specifications for Hawthorne Airport located at 12101 Crenshaw Blvd., Hawthorne, CA 90250

BID PROPOSAL, SPECIFICATIONS, AND PLANS

All contractors will need to create a free account. Once they have created an account then they will need to apply for the *Public Works Bid Plans and Specifications*. Fill in all necessary information and once the application is submitted the Contractor will receive an invoice (see project information section below for price). Once all fees have been paid the Contractor will then receive three (3) PDFs: 1) general information/provisions PDF, 2) bid proposal forms PDF (see *SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS* section below for instructions on how to submit all proposals) and 3) specifications/plans PDF.

NOTE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS: THE COST OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS IS \$150.00 (non-refundable).

CLASSIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS

Contractors bidding this project must possess a valid State of California A and C-10 and must meet minimum requirements set forth in the Specifications. The Contractor must be able to document five (5) years of satisfactory experience on project of similar complexity and dollar value and must provide a list of related construction projects at airports using FAA-specified materials.

MANDATORY PRE-BID JOB WALK

A mandatory pre-bid meeting job walk will be conducted at the Hawthorne Airport located at 12101 Crenshaw Blvd., Hawthorne, CA 90250 on **Monday, May 4, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.** All Bidders shall sign a Sign-In sheet at the job walk. All Bidders’ questions will be answered at this time or by addenda. In addition, Bidders will have the opportunity to tour the proposed improvement and have an opportunity to talk to the City’s Consultant and City’s staff concerning any aspect of the job or the site. **BIDS WILL BE NULL AND VOID IF CONTRACTOR DOES NOT ATTEND THIS PRE-BID JOB WALK.**

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

All proposals must be physically submitted to the City Clerk's office located on the first floor of City of Hawthorne City Hall no later than 4:00 PM on Tuesday May 26th, 2026. Plans and specifications prepared and furnished for that purpose, which may be obtained through the City of Hawthorne's Citizen self-service: <http://hawthorneca-energovweb.tylerhost.net/apps/selfservice#home>.

No bid will be considered unless it conforms with the Proposal Requirements and Conditions. The City Council of the City of Hawthorne, also referred to as the City, reserves the right to reject any and all submitted proposals. Bids must be submitted in the special envelopes provided marked "Sealed Bid", and addressed to the City Clerk, and bearing on the outside the name of the bidder, address, and the name of the project for which the bid is submitted. It is the sole responsibility of the bidder to see that its bid is delivered to the proper place and received at the proper time. Any bid received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids will be returned to the bidder unopened.

Each bid shall be accompanied by bid security in the form of a bid bond, cashier's check, certified check, or in the amount of 10% of the total bid amount. All cashier's checks or certified checks must be drawn on a responsible bank doing business in the State of California and shall be made payable to the City of Hawthorne. Bid bonds must be issued by an admitted surety insurer licensed to do business in the State of California. Bids not accompanied by the required bid security will be rejected. Personal or company checks are not acceptable unless certified. The City shall return bid security of unsuccessful bidders when the successful bidder ("Contractor") enters into the Contract with the City.

A list of subcontractors shall be submitted with the bid on the form provided by the city.

Each bidder must supply all information required by the bid documents and specifications.

NONDISCRIMINATION

Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Labor Code Section 1735 requires that no discrimination be made in the employment of persons upon Public Works because of race, religious creed, color, national origin, ancestry, physical handicap, medical condition, marital status, or sex of such persons, except as provided in Government Code Section 12940. Affirmative action to ensure against discrimination in employment practices on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, or religion will also be required.

PERFORMANCE RETENTION

The successful bidder will be required to provide for performance security as provided by law. Requirements for performance retentions may be satisfied by deposit or securities specified in Section 16430 of the Government Code and in accordance with Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code.

CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION

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A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for Public Works, unless currently registered and qualified to perform Public Work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5. An unregistered contractor may only submit a bid if authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work at the time the contract is awarded.

WAGES AND EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

This proposed Contract is under and subject to Executive Order 11246, as amended, of September 24, 1965, and to the Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) and Federal Labor Provisions. The EEO requirement, labor provisions, and wage rates are included in the Specifications and Bid documents and are available for inspection at the City Clerk’s Office, City Hall, City of Hawthorne.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to the provisions of Section 1773 of the Labor Code of the State of California, the City Council has obtained the general federal prevailing rate of per diem wages in accordance with the law to be paid for the construction of the above entitled Works and Improvements and General Prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work in this locality for each craft. The schedule has been obtained from the U.S. Department for Housing and Urban Development for Community Block Grant Programs of the type and nature proposed by the City, and reference is hereby made to copies thereof on file in the Office of the City Engineer, which said copies are available to any interested party upon request. Further, a copy shall be posted at the job site during the course of construction. All Contractors submitting bids must conform to current federal minimum prevailing wages.

In addition to the Contractor’s obligations as to minimum wages rates, the Contractor shall abide by all other provisions and requirements stipulated in Sections 1770-1780, inclusive, of the Labor Code of the State of California, including, but not limited to, those dealing with the employment of registered apprentices. The responsibility of compliance with Section 1777.5 of the Labor Code shall be with the prime contractor.

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT:

By signing this Grant Agreement, Grantee assures State that it complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, (42 U.S.C., 12101 *et seq.*), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability, as well as all applicable regulations and guidelines issued pursuant to the ADA.

DBE REQUIREMENTS

Contractor or subcontractor shall take necessary and reasonable steps to ensure that DBEs have opportunities to participate in the contract (49 CFR 26)

The contractor or subcontractor shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, or sex in the performance of this contract. The contractor shall carry out applicable requirements of 49 CFR, Part 26 in the award and administration of DOT-assisted contracts. Failure by the contractor to carry out these requirements is a material breach of this contract, which may result in the termination of this contract or such other remedy, as recipient deems appropriate.

CERTIFICATION OF OFFEROR/BIDDER REGARDING DEBARMENT

By submitting a bid/proposal under this solicitation, the bidder or offeror certifies that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred or suspended by any Federal department or agency from participation in this transaction.

Certification of Lower Tier Contractors Regarding Debarment

The successful bidder, by administering each lower tier subcontract that exceeds \$25,000 as a “covered transaction”, must verify each lower tier participant of a “covered transaction” under the project is not presently debarred or otherwise disqualified from participation in this assisted project. The bidder is to provide a Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number. The bidder will accomplish this by:

2. Collecting a certification statement similar to the Certification of Offeror/Bidder Regarding Debarment, above.
3. Inserting a clause or condition in the covered transaction with the lower tier contract

The Contractor is required to obtain an “Active Status”. If the City of Hawthorne later determines that a lower tier participation failed to disclose a higher tier participant that it was excluded or disqualified at the time it entered the covered transaction, the City of Hawthorne may pursue any available remedies, including suspension and debarments of the non-compliant participant.
