



## **FIFA World Cup 2026 Construction Moratorium**

In anticipation of the FIFA World Cup and to reduce traffic congestion during this time, the City of Hawthorne will be implementing a Construction Moratorium. Unless specifically approved by the City, all construction and maintenance projects shall be terminated. The FIFA World Cup 2026 Construction Moratorium will go into effect during the following days:

- Wednesday, June 10, 2026 to Sunday, July 12, 2026

Any construction activities that require a traffic lane closure on major arterial streets and/or sidewalks are temporarily prohibited throughout the entire City during this time. These streets include, but are not limited to:

- Imperial Hwy
- 120<sup>th</sup> St
- El Segundo Blvd
- Rosecrans Ave
- Aviation Blvd
- Inglewood Ave
- Hawthorne Blvd
- Prairie Ave
- Crenshaw Blvd
- Van Ness Ave

All existing street work shall be back filled and paved and all barricades and barriers shall be removed from all travel lanes.

## **FIFA World Cup 2026 Exemption Procedures**

The City of Hawthorne will grant an exemption for emergencies where the construction project will address issues that pose an immediate threat to property damage, personal injury, or loss.
